### Within 30 minutes

**Garden of the Gods** Red sandstone rock formations. Can view by car or hiking trail  
**Manitou Springs Cliff Dwellings** Self-guided tour of ancient Anasazi dwellings  
**Miramont Castle** Forty six room, 14,000 square foot castle of a late 1800s priest.  
**Ghost Town Museum** Relive the Old West era of the Pike's Peak region.  
**Pike's Peak Cog Railway** Travel to the 14,110 foot summit of Pike's Peak on the world's highest cog railway.  
**Pike's Peak Auto Hill Climb and Race Museum** Collections of the historic annual 4th of July race.  
**Santa's Workshop / North Pole** The magic of Christmas in gift shops and rides.  
**Cave of the Winds** Twenty fascinating caverns, and a laser light show  
**Pike's Peak Highway, Summit House, and Glen Cove** A 19 mile, one-hour trip to the top of Pike's Peak, where you can visit the gift shop or restaurant.  
**Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame** Personal collections, art, live animals, and sculpture garden.  
**Seven Falls** The grandest mile of scenery in Colorado. A 181 foot set water falls.
